Teacher Directions

- In order, from left to right the flip book should look like this: SYSTEMS (title), Endocrine (F), Endocrine (M), Excretory, Muscular, Nervous, Skeletal, Integumentary, Circulatory, Digestive, Reproductive (F), Reproductive (M), Respiratory, BODY (title)
- There are small tabs on each of the pages. The glue is meant to go on TOP of the tab. The tabs shouldn't be seen when glued together.
- Fold the book accordion style so that the title is shown when closed.

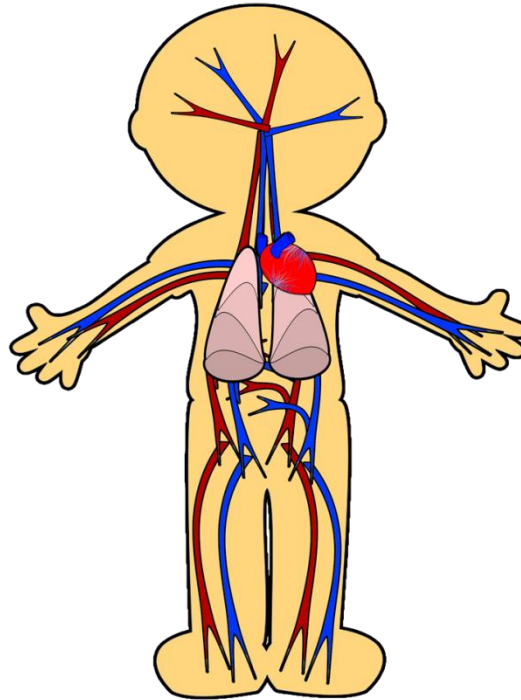
